



## **RILEM COMMITMENT TO SCIENTIFIC COLLABORATION AND INTEGRITY STATEMENT**

The International Union of Laboratories and Experts in Construction Materials, Systems and Structures (RILEM) was founded in June 1947 with the aim to promote scientific cooperation in the area of construction materials and structures. This mission is achieved through collaboration of leading experts in construction practice and science including academics, researchers, testing laboratories and authorities. RILEM aims to connect researchers and practitioners worldwide and to promote high-quality, safe, and sustainable construction practices. RILEM is an independent scientific body, committed to fostering scientific collaboration that transcends political, national, or ideological divisions. The association's mission is to advance knowledge in the field of construction materials through open, inclusive, and respectful worldwide cooperation.

RILEM rules do not support the exclusion of individual members on the basis of nationality, institutional affiliation, social, or political context. Scientific work, grounded in natural laws, must remain independent of political considerations. RILEM's activities are focused on materials science and engineering, a domain that serves civil purposes and stands apart from political or diplomatic agendas.

RILEM does not associate individual membership with institutional endorsement, nor does it interpret scientific cooperation as support for any political position. Membership in RILEM reflects a shared commitment to advancing knowledge, not alignment with specific policies or ideologies.
