Workshop place: University of Bath, Claverton Down, BA2 7AY

- **Train**

Bath Spa train station is in the City Centre of Bath and provides an excellent link with Bristol (10-15 minutes) and London (1h30 minutes).

- **Bus**

Bath Unibus Service U1 runs regularly (every 5-10 minutes) between the City Centre and the University of Bath (UoB), and it is the best option for reaching the University from the City Centre. The most central U1 bus stop towards the UoB campus is on **Dorchester Street** across the Central Bath Bus Station and the Bath Spa train station. From there the trip to the campus is approximately 10-15 minutes. More information on the bus travel to UoB can be found [here](#).

- **Car**

To access the car parking on campus it is best to apply for an Occasional User permit which will allow you to park for £1.40/day. You can apply online for a parking permit [here](#) and pay [here](#). Note that without the permit, the Pay to Park prices apply for visitors (£1/hour for Mon-Friday, limited to 6 hours). The closest car park to the NetZero Workshop is the East Car Park, which has 7 EV spaces with 7KW Mennekes socket at £0.45/kWh. More information on the EV parking [here](#).

- **Cycling**
