

1.1. G Maritime structures

The working group “Maritime structures” is meant to cover all the potential threats and special care for all infrastructures that are in close contact with the marine environment.

The goal of the group Maritime structures is to collect, prepare and share information related to the challenges and solutions for any type of construction that has direct contact with seawater.

It is also part of the scope of this group to foster debate and common work about the basic guidelines related with standardization and recommendations for safe development of these activities.

The work plan and expected deliverables for the group Maritime structures is organized as follows:

Phase 1: (September- December 2020)

- Kick-off meeting of the group and designation of a coordinator
- Meetings to prepare a guide about maritime structures
- Webinars to introduce the topics and present conclusions

For practical reasons, the dates for these meetings are already fixed:

- 12 January 2021
- 6 April 2021
- 29 June 2021
- 16 November 2021

All these meeting will be held by video conference, and are always scheduled on a Tuesday, from 9 to 10:30.

Phase 2:

- Publication of the guide in English and webinar to present it to the public
- Request translation to other languages by National Associations or other partners
- Edition of the guide in multiple languages

Phase 3:

- Record on-line descriptive course in English based on the contents of the guide
- Start a series of internal workshops about standardization and best practices related to maintenance and repair of maritime structures
- Compile common recommendations for safe development of these activities.
